Articling Program

The British Columbia Law Institute (BCLI) and the Canadian Centre for Elder Law (CCEL) are seeking a candidate for the 2010 – 2011 Law Society Admission Program (Articling and PLTC) commencing May 2010.

The opportunity is suitable for a third year law student, graduating spring 2010, or law graduate interested in commencing the Law Society Admission Program.

Position Description

The articling position will be located at the BCLI's offices in Annex 1, Law Faculty, UBC.

The primary period of articles will comprise training and experience with BCLI, and its division the Canadian Centre for Elder Law (CCEL), and will involve legal research, analysis and writing relating to law reform and public legal education and outreach relating to law reform.

The articling period will also involve a secondment for up to sixteen weeks in duration with Boughton Law Corporation for training and experience in solicitor and litigation work.

The salary range for this position is based on \$ 40,000 per annum.

The position is conditional on confirmation by BCLI of funding for this position prior to the commencement of the articling term.

Submitting an Application

Applications should be submitted to Jim Emmerton, Executive Director. The application package should include:

- a cover letter with expression of interest;
- a resume
- record of law school marks; and
- a sample of the applicant's legal writing which demonstrates experience in legal research and analysis (five pages maximum).
